Priorities:

Strategy:

1. Engage the FAA and responsible parties to address night flights with the Port of Seattle.

- 2. Committee Member Brush suggested that the previous community forums did not include the most affected communities in any meaningful conversation. The Committee favors the idea of a letter being sent to the Port of Seattle regarding the type and timing of the previous engagement by the Port, pointing out the type of engagement the affected communities need in order to have open dialogue. It was suggested that the committee draft a letter to the Port, possibly with the four City consortium and/or present this issue at a Highline Forum meeting.
