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
# **Airport Basics**



### Seattle-Tacoma International Airport

A premier international gateway serving the Puget Sound region and Washington state.

Operated by the Port of Seattle, Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA, KSEA) is ranked as the eighth busiest U.S. airport, serving 49.8 million passengers and more than 432,315 metric tons of air cargo in 2018. With a regional economic impact of more than \$22.5 billion in business revenue, Sea-Tac generates more than 151,400 jobs (87,300 direct jobs), representing over \$3.6 billion in direct earnings and more than \$442 million in state and local taxes. Thirty-two passenger airlines (/sea-tac/airlines-destinations) serve 91 non-stop domestic destinations (/page/non-stop-domestic-routes) and 29 international destinations (/page/non-stop-international-routes) including Canada,



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
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
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


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

#### Second Chance Noise Insulation Initiative

The San Francisco International Airport's (SFO) <u>Second Chance Noise Insulation Initiative</u> is intended to provide acoustical improvements to qualifying residential properties that meet certain eligibility requirements. These improvements are offered at no cost to eligible property owners. This initiative gives a second chance to participate in the Noise Insulation Program (NIP) to owners that did not participate in previous phases of the NIP.

To be considered, the property must be located inside a specific "noise boundary" corresponding to the area where the average daily aircraft noise level is equal to or greater than 65 decibels. This contour is designated as the 65-dB CNEL noise contour in the <a href="SFO Noise">SFO Noise</a> Exposure Map, as accepted by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). Future phases of this Initiative may consider properties outside this noise contour on a case by case basis, depending on the dwelling's proximity to the 65-dB contour and availability of funds.

**Second Chance Noise Insulation:** Owners of residential properties who declined participation in previous phases of the NIP, or were non-responsive to invitations to participate, may be considered for inclusion in the Second Chance Initiative if they express their desire to participate and meet all the eligibility requirements. Specific eligibility criteria include:

- The structure and significant additions must have been built before October 1, 1998.
- Preliminary eligibility is confirmed after a site visit by SFO.
- Final eligibility is confirmed based on the results of acoustical tests conducted in habitable rooms of the property.
- The owner(s) of the property must grant a perpetual avigation easement on behalf of SFO and the City & County of San Francisco.

The extent of noise insulation and the types of improvements depend on certain factors, per FAA requirements and guidelines. If eligible for full noise insulation, allowable improvements may include window and door replacement, caulking, weather-stripping, and installation of central fresh air ventilation (if the residence does not already have central ventilation).
