no wall insulation  
largest window failed  
double pane

victim ② 1942 house 900 sq ft 17 yrs ago incl. Part Phg  
northern extension of the Part 150

\* landing pollution is worse  
cellulose insulation - no "R" value or raise  
other partially insulated  
she and her dog both have auto-immune disease  
front window failed - moldy  
structural foundation issues & w/body

Rose - water under her home shifting br. gr. water movement

③ 1989 Blk 3rd Runy - installed air exchange inside the house  
sust accommodation, sleep deprivation led to flights - found  
out sleep apnea study. Feels like Touch-and-go on the roof  
frequency interference every 1.28 seconds 3rd Runway  
security door screws have <sup>been</sup> sheered off. also hears 2nd Runy  
his home done in '97  
contractor was PCL Blt in '77

1927 - Doreen - across st - not a historical treatment  
froggy, some won't open Woodmont Elem. School on 16th & 272nd
