The City of Burien has Burien Municipal Code (BMC) chapter 15.12 on Aircraft Noise Reduction. Since the Port does not have model ordinances, Dave Kaplan, Port of Seattle, will present various ordinances/codes from other cities on aviation issues at the March 15, 2022 BAC meeting.

City staff will do a presentation on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Ambaum-Boulevard Park Plans at the March 15, 2022 BAC meeting.

b) Update on StART (SEA Stakeholder Advisory Round Table) activities.

City Attorney Garmon Newson II provided an update on StART including noise measurements at various locations and maps showing noise from takeoffs and engine runups impacting Burien the most. No specific dates were provided for the release of the Sustainable Airport Master Plan (SAMP), but it should be issued in the near future.

c) Discuss doing a briefing to Council on BAC activities at March 28th Study Session.

Mayor Aragon would like to do an educational presentation to Council on Committee activities. It may be at the March 28th Study Session or another future Council meeting. Committee member Jeff Harbaugh indicated he would be interested in helping with the presentation.

d) Review Burien Airport Committee draft workplan.

The Committee reviewed the draft workplan and subcommittees may be formed to work on the various topics. It was mentioned that the Port of Seattle website has lots of useful information.

e) Federal Legislative Updates.

Mayor Aragon and Chair Schilling provided an update on their meeting with Congressman Adam Smith and three federal airport bills that are underway: HR 6050 Aviation Noise and Emissions Mitigation Act, Infrastructure bill, and Aviation Impacted Communities Act.

They will be attending the National League of Cities Conference in Washington D.C. in mid-March where they plan to meet with various federal legislators about airport issues.
