#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

#### 2. APPROVE DRAFT MINUTES

a) The minutes from the July 21, 2020 Burien Airport Committee (BAC) meeting were approved. Committee member Nekya Johnson abstained.

#### 3. BUSINESS AGENDA

b) Discuss a BAC workplan for presentation to and approval of the Burien City Council (activities may include presentations on flight paths, updates and recommendations for post SAMP EA, interactions with Port Commissioners, etc.).

The order of the agenda was changed slightly, with the Burien Airport Committee (BAC) workplan moved to the first item. Committee members provided input on potential workplan topics. Topics included community outreach, state and federal legislative agenda items, FAA lawsuit follow-up, Port investments in communities, orientation materials for new BAC members; Walt Bala's work on airport safety, environmental justice; preparation for release of SAMP EA, need for second major international airport, and noise complaints.

ACTION: Chair Tosta with help of Management Analyst Lori Fleming will compile the proposed list of workplan topics and send out to the Committee to prioritize.

#### a) Discuss Chairpersonship of the Burien Airport Committee (BAC).

Committee discussed if a new Chairperson is desired for BAC, which would need to be another Councilmember. After discussion, Chair Tosta agreed to continue as the Chairperson. It was suggested that subcommittees on various topics may be helpful.

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c) Discuss potential recommendation on StART to be made to the Burien City Council. The Committee discussed their concerns about rejoining the SeaTac Stakeholder Advisory Round Table (StART), including incomplete negotiations with the Port on StART changes, not being at the table, need for other ways to connect with the Port, and strong representation if do rejoin.

<u>RECOMMENDATION TO BURIEN CITY COUNCIL:</u> A strong majority of the Burien Airport <u>Committee voted to **not** rejoin StART. (6 voted to not rejoin; 2 voted to rejoin; and 1</u> <u>abstained. Ex-officio member City Manager Wilson supports rejoining</u>)
