### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Brian Davis called the Burien Airport Committee meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

### 2. ROLL CALL

### 3. APPROVE MINUTES

- a) **Minutes** of the April 15, 2025, Burien Airport Committee Meeting

***Moved by Sarah Moore and seconded by Jeff Harbaugh. Minutes were approved unanimously.***

### 4. BUSINESS AGENDA

- a) **Committee Member Reports**

Vice Chair Davis shared information about conversations with the County Assessor's Office and Burien staff and how the value properties under the flight path. Additionally, discussions are continuing to build relations with other airport concerned entities. Lastly, he provided public comment at the Port Commission meeting.

Committee member Harbaugh gave an update on the recent StART meeting.

Chair Moore noted that she was selected to have a noise test conducted on her home by Port of Seattle to see if it meets the noise criteria for a port package.

b) **Review of BAC Purpose and Priorities**

The committee spent time thinking about how to define the coming years' priorities and work plan. The committee approved Jeff Harbaugh and Louis Troisi to work as a sub-committee to undertake an initial reworking of the committee work plan for review by the committee.

c) **Legislative Priorities and Timeline**

The committee discussed the idea of putting forward to Council a passenger facilities charge that could benefit Burien and other airport adjacent cities for inclusion on their legislative agenda.

Additionally, the committee would like to promote the Council's support of SB5652 and several King County environmental initiatives if they are brought back to in the next legislative session.

d) The committee approved Chair Moore and Vice Chair Davis working on legislative items as a sub-committee.

**Possible Questions to Submit to Port Commissioner Candidates**

The committee determined that attending these forums would be better managed by attendance in a personal capacity by committee members or to submit recommended questions to the City Council for them to submit to various candidate forums on behalf of Burien.

Dave Kaplan provided some additional context on several Port related items and noted which Port Commissioners were running for re-election.
