#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Mayor Matta. Members and guests introduced themselves.

#### 2. APPROVE MINUTES

- a) The minutes for the February 16, 2021 Burien Airport Committee meeting were approved.
- b) The minutes for the March 16, 2021 Burien Airport Committee meeting were approved.

### 3. BUSINESS AGENDA

The business agenda order was adjusted to accommodate late arrival of a Committee member.

- a) Welcome to new Burien Airport Committee members.

- d) Update on selection of remaining Burien Airport Committee member and StART community representatives.

City Manager Brian Wilson provided general information about StART (SEA Stakeholder Advisory Round Table) for the new members and indicated the selection process for

Burien's two StART community members will begin in next couple weeks. Recruitment continues for remaining Burien Airport Committee member.

# e) Update on StART (SEA Stakeholder Advisory Round Table), including Noise and Federal Policy Working Groups.

City Manager Wilson provided an update on the StART Noise Working Group meeting held April 12, 2021. Late night air carriers that exceeded noise thresholds in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2021 continue to be mostly cargo airlines. The Runway Use Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has helped reduce the usage of the third runway from Midnight to 5:00am.

Noise Abatement Departure Procedures were reviewed, and airlines are starting to use a Distant versus Close-in takeoff procedure. Using a Distant takeoff procedure adversely impacts Burien and Des Moines, so those cities and StART are discussing the related noise data, impacts, and trends.

The quality of the noise data being gathered by the noise monitors was questioned with assurance that these monitors are properly functioning. The Port of Seattle website has specific noise monitoring system data available. Airplanes are quieter today, but there are more of them.

City Manager Wilson provided an update on the Federal Policy Working Group meeting held on April 5, 2021 which included correspondence with the FAA on the Neighborhood Environmental Survey (NES) and Airport Improvement Program.

The draft Sustainable Airport Master Plan (SAMP) will be issued by the Port of Seattle this summer. The four cities of Burien, Des Moines, Normandy Park, and SeaTac have jointly hired a consultant to review the SAMP. Burien also has its own consultant.

#### c) Discussion on review and input to applicable Port Commission meeting items.

The Committee agreed that reviewing Port Commission meeting agendas and providing input to applicable items would be valuable.

<u>ACTION:</u> City Manager Wilson and staff liaison Lori Fleming will review Port Commission agendas and highlight issues for the Committee.

# b) Presentation on Community Health and Airport Operations Noise-Air Pollution by Kris Johnson, PhD, Public Health Seattle and King County.

A state-funded study shows that those living in airport communities have worse health outcomes than the rest of the county. These include:

- Higher rate of hospitalization rates for heart diseases, strokes, and diabetes.
- Higher rate of death, and lower life expectancy (2-5 years lower).
- Higher premature birth rates.
- More children and adults living in or near poverty.

The study showed that airport related noise and air pollution likely cause hypertension, poor school performance, respiratory problems, cardiovascular and other health issues. The University of Washington MOV-UP study on ultra-fine particles showed these particles are emitted by both traffic and aircraft sources. These ultra-fine particles are not regulated and can pass through cells barriers. Mitigation efforts are recommended for these health impacts, along with continued development and implementation of strategies to reduce exposure to these pollutants.

<u>ACTION</u>: This presentation on community health and airport operations-related pollution was recommended to be shared with StART.
