Dave Kaplan, Port of Seattle, presented information regarding ordinances/codes from other cities on aviation issues and noise reduction. A brief discussion followed about noise remediation for Burien residents.

Alex Hunt, Planner, gave a presentation on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Ambaum-Boulevard Park Plans.

City Attorney Garmon Newsom II provided an update on sharing that the Port of Seattle is receiving over \$6M in grants for environmental purposes; the SAMP has been delayed due to NEPA considerations until sometime before October 30, 2022; the FAA has shared that the Port would need to submit a written request to the FAA if it wanted an extended comment period; and the Port is considering changes in the airport layout.
- d) Discuss doing a briefing to Council on BAC activities at March 28th Study Session.**
Mayor Aragon was absent and no discussion on this topic occurred. Mayor Aragon would like to do an educational presentation to council on committee activities. It may be at the March 28th study session or another future council meeting. Committee member Jeff Harbaugh indicated he would be interested in helping with the presentation.
