1. CALL TO ORDER

Brian Davis called the Burien Airport Committee meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

3. APPROVE MINUTES

- a) **Minutes** of the March 17, 2026, Burien Airport Committee Meeting

Motion to approve minutes by Karen Veloria and seconded by Jeff Harbaugh. Minutes were approved unanimously.

4. BUSINESS AGENDA

- a) **Introduction to Emily Inlow-Hood** – The Committee welcomed their newest member, Emily Inlow-Hood, who provided brief introduction of herself.
- b) **National Airport Roundtable Network** – Jeff Harbaugh and Joe Dusenbury, Chair of the Des Moines Airport Advisory Committee, provided a recap of the most recent meeting of this new roundtable organization. The network is a roundtable of other airport roundtable groups (similar to StART) from around the country. The roundtable group could be a good resource for future collaboration and information sharing on a wide range of airport issues.
- c) **Port Commission Response to Council** – Mayor Moore walked the Committee through the Port Commission’s letter responding to the Council’s letter requesting revisions be made to the Sound Insulation Program (aka Port packages). The Committee continues to disagree with the Port’s evaluation criteria to determine whether Port packages are still effective and if homes qualify for a Port Package.

- d) **StART Steering Committee Appointments** – The Committee discussed who may be able to fill the vacant city official positions on the StART Committee and the StART Steering Committee. Jeff Harbaugh voiced interest and suggested combining efforts with Des Moines’s advisory committee.
- e) **SAMP SEPA Strategy Team** – The Port of Seattle has indicated release of the SAMP SEPA assessment in late May or early June. Vice Chair Davis proposed the Committee designate a small strategy group to review the document once it is released and help prepare recommendations for the City Council.
- f) **South King and Port Community Fund Analysis Team** – Vice Chair Davis proposed reviewing the list of grant recipients in more detail to evaluate the benefits provided to Burien and what types of programs are being funded benefitting Burien.
- g) **North of NERA Feedback** – The Committee continued to debate the merits and impacts of the proposed North of NERA rezoning. The Committee may review its resolution to better clarify its role in making recommendations on airport impacts on a broader range of City projects.

5. NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business brought to the Committee.

6. PUBLIC COMMENT

Dave Kaplan – Port of Seattle – Mr. Kaplan provided additional information on the appointed City employee positions to StART and the upcoming meeting dates. He also provided additional information on the South King and Port Community Fund grants and the North of NERA rezonings tie-in to PSRC.
