SEATAC NOISE PROJECTS

The Northwest Mountain Region has actively participated in the land acquisition program at Seattle-Tacoma Airport. Sea-Tac has received 13 AIP grants since 1982 totaling over \$50 million dollars in federal funds for the acquisition of approximately 750 parcels of land impacted by noise. In FY 89 alone Sea-Tac received two grants totaling \$9,880,766 in federal funds for 121 parcels. To date 48 houses in the land acquisition are yet to be funded for \$4.6 million.

The Northwest Mountain Region and Sea-Tac have worked together on a noise insulation program to help serve the community surrounding Sea-Tac. The first AIP grant funded a demonstration project and has been followed by three additional grants. The four grants totaled over \$7 million dollars in federal funds and insulated 323 houses. In FY 89 alone Sea-Tac received a grant for 43.2 million dollars in federal funds to insulate 175 houses. The Port and ANM have recently worked together on a public building insulation program also. The Port has requested federal funds in the amount of \$3.2 million dollars per year for the next four years to insulate approximately 175 houses per year.
