Directions to the Highline School District's Educational Resource Activity

Center – SR 509 from the North: Take SR 509 south to the S. 160th Street exit. Turn right onto S. 160th Street. The second light is 1st Avenue S. Go through the intersection and turn diagonally onto Ambaum Blvd SW. The ERAC is in the wooded parking lot on your left, just before S. 156th Avenue. I-5 from the North: Take I-5 south and take the SR 518 west exist toward Burien (as if heading to the Airport). Continue until 1st Avenue S, and take a left (south.) At S. 158th Street, take a right. At Ambaum Blvd S, take a right. The ERAC is in the wooded parking lot on your left, just before S. 156th Avenue. Hwy 99 from the South: Take Pacific Hwy S/International Blvd to S. 188th Street. Take a right where the road deadends, onto 1st Avenue S. Continue on 1st Ave S to S. 160th street, and get into the left turn lane that directs you diagonally onto Ambaum Blvd SW. Go through the intersection and turn diagonally onto Ambaum Blvd SW. The ERAC is in the wooded parking lot on your left, just before S. 156th Avenue.
