# **Workforce Development is a Port Priority**

- Century Agenda
  - Advance regional workforce development in port-related industries to provide equitable access to quality careers
- Regional Demographics
  - More women and diverse communities participating in the labor force
- Workforce Development Resolution 3776
  - Workforce development is critical to achieving the Port's mission
  - Investments in Port sectors (aviation, maritime, construction, green careers
- RCW 53.08.245(2)(c)
  - Washington State Legislature legal authority





# 2021 Results of Investments (ROI)

#### Impact of Investments

- ✓ \$3.7 million workforce development funds invested in port sectors
  - 1,312 job placements (aviation and construction)
  - 259 training completions
  - $\,\circ\,$  37 youth participated in maritime experiential learning
  - \$1.7 million invested in 2021 in the Opportunity Youth Initiative supported 291 youth who earned \$16-\$20 hourly

### ✓ Job Types

- $\,\circ\,$  Janitorial, food service, ramp/airfield, customer service, airfreight
- Apprentice ironworkers, laborers, pipefitters, bricklayers, cement masons

### ✓ Average Wages Earned


Aviation \$17.02, Construction \$25.61






# **Communities Served**

  - ✓ Most from South King County






# **Workforce Development Strategies**
