WHEREAS, King County recognizes the need to participate in this study because of the significant concerns of the citizens of South King County regarding the development of the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and the environmental concerns such development raises, and

WHEREAS, a joint Port of Seattle-King County planning effort will ultimately help solve the problems of land-use, access, and environmental relationships,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration for said grant assistance in the amount of approximately \$640,000.
- That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any agreements between King County and other cooperating public bodies to effect the purposes and intent of this motion.
- That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration.
- That the proposed joint Master Plan Study to be undertaken by King County and the Port of Seattle is consistent with the long range planning needs of King County and such application should be approved.

5. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the U. S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration.
