A. General Issues

Whether appellant has proven that there is not reasonable assurance that the Port of Seattle's projects at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport ("STIA") reviewed in Ecology's §401 Certification will comply with water quality standards and other applicable standards under §401 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
- 2. Whether it was necessary to identify and specify performance standards for structures requiring a dam safety permit prior to issuance of the §401 Certification.

- Whether public notice for the §401 Certification violated applicable statutes and 8. regulations.

B. Impacts To Wetlands

Whether the Natural Resources Mitigation Plan provides adequate mitigation for the 9. wetlands proposed to be filled as part of the Port's projects reviewed in the §401 Certification.

C. Potential Stream Flow Reductions

- Whether the mitigation required by the §401 Certification is adequate to avoid or 10. minimize reductions in stream flow so as to provide reasonable assurance that water quality standards will be met.
- Whether a water right is required to implement the Port's low stream flow mitigation 11. plan.

D. Stormwater And Other Water Quality Issues

12. Whether stormwater releases from the Port's projects reviewed in the §401 Certification will violate water quality standards.
