

The files contained on the CD volumes are as follows: two Word files, which include an index of all the documents with hyper-links; the scanned images in Adobe PDF format; the “Missing Exhibits” file; and this “readme” file. The PDF files are split up into folders which correspond to the box order of the scanned originals. If you do not have Adobe Acrobat Reader, a free copy has been provided on the first CD volume as well. A more detailed inventory of the contents of the CD volumes is included below.

In order for the links embedded in the Word documents to work properly, all of the files from all the CD volumes (the folders containing the PDFs and the Word documents themselves) must be copied into a common folder on a local hard drive or on a network server. The files should not be moved out of their proper “box number” folder, nor should the files or folders be re-named as it will cause the links in the Word tables to fail.

Within the Word documents, the links to the PDF files show up as *blue* text, ***black*** text means that the exhibit was withdrawn, and *red* text indicates that the exhibit was not present at time of capture. All exhibits in red text correspond to the contents of the file entitled “Missing Exhibits.”
