Brett and Wanda I've contacted the Port (John Rothnie 997-4107) (about using the runway as a site for disposal. John said geotechnically and environmentally the material looks good from the information that Pat has sent them. John needs to work out some details with regard to the rate of delivery, timing, working hours, etc. Apparently if we send more than 6 trucks per hour the City of Seatac may require them to get a special permit. I estimated that we would start hauling in June and complete sometime in august. Brett can you please contact him and discuss some of these issues in more detail and let me know of any problems.

He said there is some concern about the material becoming to wet, I told him if that happens we may need to fine an alternative site. For the real wet material we will need to let it dewater on site then take it may be to the commercial site that we have found. I'll be meeting his geotechnical person at the site in the near future.

Wanda what kind of agreement do we need to have with the Port of Seattle? Will a memorandum of understanding suffice?

Also if you are interested the port has designed the runway to use what would normally be considered marginal material and will be filling for the next 3 years. If you have other projects you may one to consider contacting
