DELIVERABLE 6 (PINK) KING COUNTY FREDBACK

Deliverable 6 consists of a memo documenting the feasibility of maintaining the proposed large vaults. The Port will strengthen the language of bullet #1, page 2, regarding the 3 viable maintenance options, and will resubmit D6 in yellow for review.

The Port will add a section 7.8 to the SMP water quality section in order to describe the Port's standard maintenance procedures (e.g. O&M manuals, SWPPP applicates, consistent with KCSWDM). This addition will be submitted to Ecology and King County as a component of Deliverable 8 "Volume I."

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DELIVERABLE 3 (PINK) KING COUNTY FEEDBACK

The Port will make the following revisions to the pink Deliverable 3 "Des Moines Creek" in response to King County comments.

- The footnote in Table 4-3 will be revised to describe which pump stations overflow to stream (the footnote currently refers to the entire table).
- Because SASA is now included in Appendix D, the Appendix D sheet list will be revised to include SASA.
- Figure D-2 (SASA) revisions:
 - o The Port will check the exact elevation of the pond outfall pipe in order to accurately depict its elevation relative to map contours.
 - The footprint edge of SASA will be included on the drawing and conveyance will be shown from SASA to the SASA pond.
 - o The boundary of wetland 52 will be shown on the drawing.
 - o The Port will confirm the slope of the retaining wall. If steeper than 3:1, fencing will be shown on the drawing.
- Appendix B (Calibration Report) revisions:
 - Page B1-5 text edit: 2nd to the last bullet should read Walker Creek, not Miller Creek.
 - The Port will verify if a ripple edit to the Golf Weir scattergram is necessary.
 - The March '95 calibration plot will be revised to show monitored and current (revised model and current land cover) simulated flows.
- The Port will confirm why an acreage difference appears in DM3 between pre-project and post project conditions, and will resolve the discrepancy for the yellow D3 submittal.

COMPLETE ITEM #28 SCOPING: 154TH STREET RELOCATION

The Port proposed the following solution to modeling the relocated 154th Street:

- Remove part of the SDN2X basin that drains to the west and make it a part of MC1.
- Remove the existing 154th Street roadway from pre-development land uses in SDN2X, SDN3X, SDN4X and SDN3A.
- Present a table showing impervious area to be removed in the buyout area and the impervious area of the portion of the roadway that is proposed to not drain to the regional facility (MC4) in order to compare impervious area changes.

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Ecology and King County approved this proposed solution. Participants identified the following potential ripple effects: SDN2X may get smaller; SDN3X and SDN3A may get bigger. The results of this effort will be submitted to Ecology and King County for review as Deliverable 7B.
