MANAGEMENT SUCCESS

Despite the problems cited, there are significant success stories where water quality has been improved around the Sound. Improved water quality pollution controls have had dramatically positive results. Significant and sustained efforts have also begun to reduce sources of nonpoint pollution in land. There has been considerable progress in implementing the Puget Sound Water Quality Management Plan. As a result:
