EFFECT:

- Makes several changes to the intent section;
- Authorizes a port district providing additional benefits to properties that already received sound mitigation equipment that is determined through inspection to be in need of repair or replacement to contract directly with building inspectors or other professionals with experience in sound testing, or window and door installations;
- Clarifies that a port district may contract with building inspectors or other professional with experience in sound testing or window and door installs, rather than a state certified building inspector, to determine whether package failure resulted in additional hazards or structural damage to the property; and
- Makes other technical changes.
