SEATAC COMMUNITIES PLAN

EARLY THIS YEAR THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANTED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO KING COUNTY AND THE PORT OF SEATTLE TO PREPARE A PLAN FOR SEA-TAC AIRPORT AND NEIGHBORING COMMUNITIES.
