1999 Legislative Services Contract

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into between the AIRPORT COMMUNITIES COALITION (ACC) and SMITH ALLING LANE, P.S. (Contractor).

Now, therefore, the parties agree as follows:

1. Effective February 1, 1999, Contractor will perform all basic lobbying services for the ACC according to the Scope of Work attached.

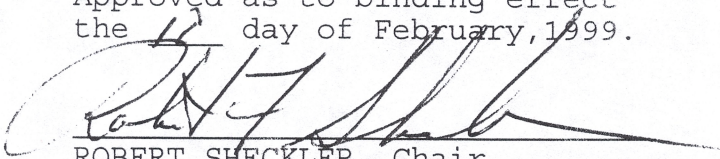
2. Contractor will receive specific direction from Robert Sheckler, Chair of the ACC Executive Committee, and such other individuals as Mr. Sheckler shall designate.

3. Contractor will be paid for their services as follows: \$3,000.00 per month, February 1-April 30, 1999, and \$3,000.00, or pro rata, for May 1999, if there is a need for assistance during a special session. Expenses shall be paid at a 10% maximum (maximum of \$300.00 per month).

4. The Legislative Services Contract is for the duration of the 1999 legislative session, but either party may terminate such contract within thirty (30) days notice.

**Airport Communities Coalition
Scope of Work**

I. Duties.

A. Assist area legislators (primarily Senator Patterson) on bills relating to airport communities on the following issues:

1. Revisions to Growth Management Act (GMA) regarding siting of essential public facilities, subordination of special district capital facilities plans to comprehensive plans of local general governments, etc. (I understand that this will be Senator Patterson's main bill, and should attract a lot of attention from counties, cities, special districts, and some state agencies.)
2. Establishment of siting commission for new and expanded airports (a House bill).
3. A study of airport noise.
4. Water quality, wetlands, and environmental protection measures related to major public construction projects.
5. Regional transportation planning.
6. Budget request for funding of a study to examine specific environmental impacts of the third runway project.
7. Port district elections (a hearing has already been held on the Senate bill; this faces an uphill battle).
8. Property acquisition and relocation.

B. Tasks related to the above:

1. Meet with ACC legislators and staff on bills identified by the legislators. (The primary contact would be Senator Patterson and her staff.)
2. Meet with other legislators to line up votes, etc.
3. Help ACC legislators and staff to coordinate:
 - a. Committee hearings testimony; and
 - b. Written material for hearings, etc.

4. Advise ACC legislators and staff on, and monitor, other bills that would affect the airport communities. These potentially include bills dealing with off-site compensatory wetlands mitigation, water quality, environmental mitigation, etc.

II. Compensation.

- A. \$3,000.00/month, February 1-April 30, 1999 (total: \$9,000.00).
- B. (\$3,000.00, or pro rata for May 1999, if there is a need for assistance during a special session.)
- C. Expenses of 10% maximum (maximum of \$300.00 per month).
