Dear Ms. Zalud:

The Zone 3 Steering Committee wishes to thank you for your application and your willingness to participate as a representative on the Policy Advisory Committee for the Sea Tac Communities Plan from the south noise impacted area.

On Monday evening, July 2, 1979, at the request of Oris Dunham-chairman of PAC, the steering committee voted to postpone further discussion or action on the issue of proper community representation on PAC until January 1980. It is our feeling that the issue has been recognized as serious, therefore we are willing to proceed with the present representation ONLY if it is agreed that the subject will be on the agenda in January.

It is our strong feeling that proper citizen representation on PAC (~~to monitor the implementation of the Sea Tac Communities Plan~~) should be by residents of the communities effected. North and South representation to come from the noise remedy areas, and East and West to come from the land use areas, as shown on the maps on the blue summary report--four citizen representatives.

Again, we thank you for your letter--it will be kept in our files so that we may keep you informed of any future action.
