Section 1. The 5 NEW SECTION. legislature finds that inadequately controlled noise adversely affects the health, safety, 6 7 and welfare of the people; the enjoyment and quality of life; and the use and value of property. There is a need, therefore for an 8 expansion of efforts state-wide directed toward the abatement and 9 10 control of noise. To carry out this purpose, it is desirable to centralize in the department of social and health services, office of 11 12 environmental health programs, the authority to adopt reasonable 13 state-wide standards for noise emissions permitted within this state and to implement and enforce compliance with such standards. 14

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. In accordance with the applicable 16 provisions of chapter 34.04 RCW the department of social and health 17 services, office of environmental health programs, shall promulgate 18 reasonable rules relating to the control of levels of noise emitted 19 into the environment of this state and including the following:
