

### SEA-TAC COMMUNITIES PLAN STUDY AREA

THE STUDY INVOLVES AN AREA OF 44.2 SQUARE MILES BOUNDED BY: NORTH - ROXBURY AND TRENTON STS.; EAST - FREEWAY AND 51ST SO.; SOUTH - SO. 288TH; AND WEST - PUGET SOUND. THIS IN-CLUDES ALL OF THE INCORPORATED CITIES OF NORMANDY PARK AND DES MOINES AND PORTIONS OF SEATTLE, TUKWILA AND KENT. THE COMMUNITIES OF BURIEN AND WHITE CENTER ARE ALSO INCLUDED. THE 1970 CENSUS INDICATES A POPULATION OF 137,000 FOR THE STUDY AREA.
